Treasurers Report AGM 2023

The accounts are complete and with the Auditor for scrutiny.

The front page of this year's accounts shows an increase in the funds for the year 1st June 2022 to 31st May 2023 of £184.30 giving us a holding of £9,728.62 represented by the two SCBA bank accounts.

The second page gives a split of the 2022 – 2023 Financial Year between the budget purse headings and again shows the overall increase of £184.30 against a loss of £680.00 the previous year.

However, the financial year is a fixed period in time and does not exactly reflect the current season with transactions for previous seasons carrying through a month or two into the next financial year's figures.

The next page gives a breakdown of the figures for the 2022-2023 season split between the budget purse headings and shows a decrease in the Associations funds of £81.31 to date.

There have been no administration costs requested.

The only Development costs have been an umpire course sponsorship of £30.00.

The Masters purse shows a loss of £1,612.80 but I am informed that there is still approximately £900.00 of match fees with team captains to be paid into the account.

Membership income increased from £2,761.34 last season to £4,161.68 this season.

The Senior teams had a cost to the association of £3,592.66 against a budget of £4,000.00 that is £802.94 less than last season. There is however only 11 tubes of shuttles in stock which is a net decrease of 37 tubes (£813.63) over last season.

The Other income/expenditure purse shows a decrease of £188.61 which consists of a charity donation and some interest on banked funds.

The 3 Series Plus made a slight loss of £68.92 over the four events and the Restricted realised a profit of £1,250 due to the increased entry fee.

The 2021-2022 Season split between the budget purse headings has been amended to the final end of season figures and show a loss of £286.66 as opposed to £272.28 reported at the last AGM.

Overall, we managed this season with only a very slight financial loss of £81.31. However, as mentioned earlier there is some £900.00 with the Masters Captains still to be paid into the account and we are down by £813.63 on shuttle stocks against last season. Therefore, we are looking at a £5.06 nett increase on the season. This is a much healthier picture than we had last season where we had a £272.28 loss even with £1,400 sponsorship money. Membership income has returned to a more expected level post covid.

The final page is confirmation that last year's accounts were audited.

I have a breakdown of every transaction if anyone needs further information.
